ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, permission was accorded to the Director of Health to fill up two hundred and seventy six (276) vacant posts of Staff Nurses reserved for Scheduled Tribe candidates that have remained unfilled for want of trained persons with trained /untrained S.T. candidates and then depute the untrained candidates to study the GNM course in Government Training Institutions duly following the procedure indicated below:-

- (a) relaxation of training qualification for appointment of Scheduled Tribe girls in the sanctioned posts of Staff Nurse earmarked for S.T. candidates;
- (b) local ST girls with Intermediate qualification to be selected on merit basis.
- (c) after appointment, the candidates to be sent for GNM training course in the Government Training Institutions/Institutions recognized by Government.
- (d) The candidates admitted in the training institutions will receive their pay as inservice candidates. Hence, the training cost will be borne by the individuals themselves. In case, the training cost is to be borne by the Government, then the candidate would not receive monthly salary and in lieu receive post metric scholarships, including fees reimbursement.
- 2. In the Government Memo 2nd read above, Government has directed to consider the cases of the Scheduled Tribe girls who have already completed the GNM training course and fully qualified as Staff Nurses in terms of G.O.Ms.No.35, HM & FW (J2) Department, dt.31.01.2009.
- 3. The Director of Health, A.P., Hyderabad vide letter 3rd read above, has requested to issue guidelines and define the procedure for filling 276 backlog vacancies of Staff Nurses with S.T. Candidates. The Director of Medical Education vide letter 4th read above has submitted draft guidelines and procedure for filling the vacant posts. The Regional Director of Medical and Health Services, Visakhapatnam in her letter dated 04.02.2010 has also proposed certain guidelines for filling up the vacancies of Staff Nurses.
- 4. After careful examination of the proposal, the Government is pleased to permit the Director of Health to fill up two hundred seventy six (276) vacant posts of Staff Nurses reserved for S.T. candidates that have already been sanctioned duly following the procedure indicated below:-
 - (a) Qualified S.T. candidates working as ANMs (Regular and Contract) holding GNM/B.Sc., (N) qualification shall be given first preference for appointment, duly considering the marks obtained in the qualifying examination. S.T. candidates with GNM/B.SC., (N) qualification shall be considered next, duly considering their merit.

- (b) Male S.T. candidates who have completed the GNM training, be considered after considering the claims of all female candidates with GNM/B.Sc., (N) qualification.
- (c) After filling the posts, with qualified candidates, candidates with Intermediate qualification with Biology, Chemistry and Physics shall be considered, in order of merit based on marks obtained in the Intermediate course in the three sciences subjects, excluding languages.
- (d) Selection of the candidates shall be made by the following Committee:-

District Collector of the district in which Zonal office is located

concerned district

Regional Director Member / Convener

- (e) In case of any ambiguity in the process of selection, the Chairman of the Committee is empowered to decide the process under information to the Government.
- (f) The Regional Director of Medical and Health Services concerned shall give notification through extensive publicity through media in consultation with Project Officer, I.T.D.A., / District Collector concerned.
- (g) Overall the priority for selection shall be in the following order:
 - i) Those with B.Sc., (N) degree
 - ii) Those with GNM certificate
 - iii) Those currently studying GNM/B.Sc., (N) course, duly assigning priority as per years of study i.e. Third, Second and first
 - iv) Merit as per marks obtained in Intermediate Board examination with Biology, Physics and Chemistry (not counting languages)
- (h) Age 18 to 48 years, inclusive of 5 years relaxation for S.T. candidates.
- (i) No fees shall be collected for application or any cost incurred
- (j) The Project Officers concerned shall provide names of the local S.T. candidates so as to select the candidates as per G.O.68, Social Welfare (V) Department, dt.16.04.1988. Only 'Local S.T. candidates' as defined in this Government order be selected.
- (k) Proforma application shall be prepared by the Regional Director with the approval of the selection committee.
- (I) Recruitment shall be completed by 30 April 2010 and appointment orders be issued by 10 May 2010.
- (m) The Director of Health shall submit the details of appointed candidates requiring GNM training to Director of Medical Education and ensure adequate number of seats are earmarked for such candidates in the Government Nursing Schools in the State by 20 May 2010.

5. The Director of Health, A.P., Hyderabad shall take action accordingly with immediate effect and submit action taken report to the Government by 15 May 2010.
