The following notification will be published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette:

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 read with clause (4) of the article 16 and 335 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendment to the Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from the 8th March, 1996. However, the orders issued in the G.O.Ms.No.928, GA(Ser.D) Department, dated the 6th October, 1995 will be effective upto the 7th March, 1996 only.

AMENDMENT

In the said rules, in rule 22-A, for sub-rule (2) land the proviso and the explanation there under, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

(2) In the matter of the direct recruitment to the posts for which women and men are equally suited, there shall be reservation to women an extent of 33 1/3% of the posts in each category of OC, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D, SC, ST, Physically Handicapped and Ex-Servicemen quota.

Provided that if sufficient number of women candidates are not available, the vacancies shall be filled in by men.
