**ORDER:**

The Social Welfare [T.W. Ser.I(2)] Department have stated that the Director of Tribal Welfare, A.P., Hyderabad in the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above has submitted proposal to rationalize the staffing pattern in the office of the Director of Tribal Welfare, Hyderabad stating that over a period of time, the budget and the activities of the Department of Tribal Welfare have increased many folds leading to a budget of Rs. 750 crores during 2007-08; that more than 60 lakhs tribals in the State have expectations from Tribal Welfare Department for all their needs of education, health, relief, economic support etc., and that to meet all these multifarious requirements, Government provides the following services:-

1. Runs the institution of Gurukulam, which in turn provides high quality education to more than 25,000 tribal youth through their 171 institutions such as Colleges of Excellence, Schools of Excellence, Residential Schools, Kasturba Gandhi Vidyalayas etc.
2. Provides complete educational needs of tribals in the interior areas through their 600 Ashram Schools.
3. Runs 500 hostels for the benefit of tribal students all over the State.
4. Thus all in all 3.00 lakh students are served by the department.
5. Runs 10 ITDAs for meeting all the requirements of the tribals in scheduled areas and in sub plan areas.
6. Coordinates with all the departments and ensures 6.6% of State budget from all the departments, is spent for the welfare of the tribals.
7. Implements the works programme amounting to Rs. 100 crores.

2. The Director of Tribal has further added that the Planning Commission has been emphasizing the need to monitor implementation of tribal sub plan in the State effectively; and that to execute all these functions effectively, the office of the Director Tribal Welfare needs to be reorganized and strengthened. The Director of Tribal Welfare, Hyderabad has therefore requested to sanction additional posts as hereunder;
