- 2. For these 5 hostels an amount of Rs. 95 lakhs will be provided by Sri Jairam Ramesh, M.P. (RS) from MPLADS contribution and Rs. 25.00 lakhs will be provided by State Government with Rs 120.00 lakhs as Govt. of India contribution, to whom a proposal has been submitted accordingly.
- 3. The Government after careful examination of the proposal hereby accord sanction for construction of 5 hostel buildings at the following locations as per the funding mentioned below:-

- 5. In each of the hostels 60% of the seats shall be filled by aboriginal S.T Girls hailing from Scheduled areas of the State like Gonds, Kolams, Koya, Pradhan, Konda Reddy etc. and 10% by PTGs Girls and remaining from the tribal girls from plain areas. The Hostel will be maintained as per the norms and guideline on par with the Student Managed Hostel already issued by the Tribal Welfare Department in the State
- 6. The construction work shall be monitored by concerned District Collector / P.O., ITDAs with whom funds shall be deposited. They will identify and engage Mandal Samakhya members / self help groups / village organizations / VTDAs as case may be, who will be provided requisite training. The Collectors shall take all steps to ensure timely completion with best possible quality / standards as prescribed. The Chief Engineer (Tribal Welfare) and staff agency identified shall provide requisite training and guidance and undertake periodical visits and submit quarterly report to Commissioner of Tribal Welfare, A.P., Hyderabad / Government
- 7. The Commissioner of Tribal Welfare, A.P., Hyderabad and Chief Engineer (TW) shall take immediate necessary action for releasing the funds required to District Collectors / Project Officers, ITDAs for construction of hostel buildings and take other necessary action to ensure timely completion as per prescribed standards.
