The following notification shall be published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers here unto enabling and in supersession of the special rules issued in G.O. Rt. No. 633, General Administration (Rules) Department, dated 25th April, 1958 the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following special rules, namely, the Andhra Pradesh Translation Subordinate Service Rules.

RULES

1. Short Title:

These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Translation Subordinate Services Rules, 1995.

2. Constitution:

The service shall consist of the following categories of posts.

- Category 1 (a) Senior Translator (Telugu) (formerly designated as Assistant Translator).
 - (b) Senior Translator (Urdu) (formerly designated as Assistant Translator).
 - (c) Senior Translator (Tamil) (formerly designated as Assistant Translator).

- (d) Senior Translator (Marathi) (formerly designated as Assistant Translator).
- (e) Senior Translator (Kannada) (formerly designated as Assistant Translator).
- (f) Senior Translator (Hindi) (formerly designated as Assistant Translator).


Category - 2 (a) Junior Translator (Telugu) (formerly designated as Junior Assistant Translator).

(b) Junior Translator (Urdu) (formerly designated as Junior Assistant Translator).

3. <u>Method of Appointment and appointing authority:</u>

The Method of appointment and appointing authority for the several categories shall be as follows:-

Category	Method of appointment	Appointing

1. (a) Senior Translator (Telugu)	By promotion of Junior Translator (Telugu)	Director of Translations
2. (b) Senior Translator (Urdu)	By promotion of Junior Translator (Urdu)	Director of Translations
3. (c) Senior Translator (Tamil)	By Direct recruitment	Director of Translations
4. (d) Senior Translator (Marath	i) By Direct recruitment	Director of Translations
5. (e) Senior Translator (Kannad	a) By Direct recruitment	Director of Translations
6. (f) Senior Translator (Hindi)	By Direct recruitment	Director of Translations



NOTE: 75 % of the vacancies in the category of Junior Translator (Telugu) and Junior Translator (Urdu) shall be filled by direct recruitment.

4. RESERVATION: -

- (1) In the matter of direct recruitment to the posts of Senior Translators and Junior Translators for which women and men are equally suited, other things being equal, preference shall be given to women and they shall be selected to an extent of at least 30 % of the posts in each category of OC, BC, Sc and ST quota in terms of Rule 22-A (2) of Part II of Andhra Pradesh State Subordinate Service Rules.
- (2) Rule 22 in Part II of the Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules in so far as it relates to the reservation of vacancies for the physically handicapped shall apply to the posts of Senior Translators and Junior Translators when they are appointed by direct recruitment.

5. <u>A G E :-</u>

No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment if he has completed 28 years of age on the first day of July of the year in which the notification for selection is made.

5. Qualifications:-

No person shall be eligible for appointment to the category specified in column (1) of the Annexure to these rules by the method specified in column (2) unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entry in column (3) thereof.

7. <u>Minimum Service : -</u>

No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer or promotion unless he has put in not less than three years of service in the category from which promotion or transfer is made.

8. Probation:-

- (a) Every person appointed to the posts by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he commences probation be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.
- (b) Every person appointed to the posts either by promotion or by transfer shall, from the date on which he commences probation be on probation for a total period of one year on duty, within a continuous period of two years.

9. $\underline{TESTS:}$

- (1) Every person appointed by direct recruitment shall pass the special Translation Test in the language of the section within the period of probation.
- (2) No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer or promotion unless he passes the Special Translation Test in the language of the section in which he is seeking appointment.
